DETAILS ABOUT STREAMS

Junior Creative Arts Camp is a great opportunity for young people, Grades 5 to 8, to come together to enjoy an exciting experience in the creative arts. The camp hopes to nurture these young people in their early skill development as well as assist corps in the growth of its creative arts programs.

Junior Creative Arts Camp [JCAC] will provide avenues for spiritual development for our young people through worship and bible studies designed to engage the children in an interactive way.

All children will participate in the three streams:

1. **Instrumental** – children will participate in one instrumental activity during the week. In order to accommodate all children and ensure electives have appropriate numbers you are required to provide **two** preferences
2. **Vocal** – all children will participate in vocal activities
3. **Creative** – children will participate in one creative activity during the week. In order to accommodate all children and ensure electives have appropriate numbers you are required to provide **two** preferences.

1. Instrumental

This will be a chance for everyone to experience the fun and excitement of playing an instrument. Whether you already play or join Percussion Rules, there will be something for everyone

Band

For those who have been learning for 6 months or more our band will include brass, woodwind and percussion; this will be a fantastic ensemble experience.

Guitar Ensemble

For those who have been learning the guitar for at least 12 months. This group will work as an ensemble preparing music that provides opportunity for playing both melodic material and chords. Acoustic guitars preferred.

Keyboard Ensemble

This group will work as an ensemble preparing music that provides opportunity for playing both melodic material and chords.

Percussion Ensemble

We all have the ability to play an instrument. Maybe your introduction to this wonderful experience will be through percussion. Come along and enjoy playing the full range of instruments on offer in the percussion family.

2. Vocal

Developing your skills on an instrument happens so much quicker when you can learn how to listen. We will develop our listening skills in a fun way and experience the joy of singing through learning some really cool songs.

3. Creative

Drama

Are you the 'dramatic' type? Do you think you could tell a great story? Then the Drama Elective is for you!! Challenge yourself as you work in a group to express the creative gifts you have. Come for the fun... stay for the story.

Dance

Dance at this year's camp will be for the energetic! We'll challenge ourselves to use our bodies in worship, and have fun in the process.

Visual Arts

Sometimes the best way to express something is to create something. A creator creates - when the viewer remakes. Here is your opportunity to bring to life your ideas. You have been created now show your creator how creative you are! Bring an art shirt and your imagination. .

Song- writing

Have you ever thought about writing your own song? What comes first, the lyrics or the melody? This elective will help you work through the process of creating that special song that is all yours!

Improvisation

Here's your chance to learn how to create new melodies over a cycle of chords. It's not as hard as you think. Come along and give it a try! *[Participants should have at least 12 months experience on their instrument]*
